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IN PARADISE OF THE RED DEER

THE PRIPET MARSHES - ONE OF THE LAST NATURAL PARADISES

In the south of Belarus, along the Pripet river, the largest wetland in Europe extends over an area of almost 90,000 square kilometres. The Pripet Marshes, formerly known as Roskitno Marshes, are one of the most interesting and untouched hunting areas that we can offer in Europe.

One must have seen this hunting area with the own eyes and must have experienced these dimensions in order to understand what a hunting gem this is. There are huge reed belts and forests that don't want to end. It is home to bison, moose, wild boar, red deer, wolf and lynx, to name but a few game species.

We have already visited this unique area in the early nineties and over the years we have developed our relationships and contacts with the hunting management. Today we are connected with the responsible hunting director, Mr. Stjepan Bambisa, more than just a business contact. At this point we would like to give you some more information about the hunting area. It is an area of just over 100,000 ha, an unimaginable size by western standards. Coniferous woods, a lot of softwood with natural regeneration, large open spaces, swamps, moors, flowing and standing waters everywhere, that's how you have to imagine the Pripet Marshes. Forestry is only practised in the periphery areas, occasionally you can find lonely farmsteads - the rest is pure nature!

The areas of the Pripet Marshes under the direction of Stjepan Bambisa are subject to special hunting and forestry regulations. This shows the high importance of this area. Rightly so, because you will not find anything comparable throughout Europe. Not only Russian tsars but also Polish princes hunted in the Pripet Marshes.

While in spring and summer, often until late autumn, large parts of the marshes cannot be entered, strong frost and cold offer unique possibilities. Then you can enter the remote islands in the midst of huge reed belts.

In September, when the first night frosts come, the picture of the swamps changes completely. The almost impenetrable reed belts are accessible again. The summer plague of mosquitoes has passed and the forests have become colourful. Then the time of the red deer rut has come, which the hunting staff is looking forward to all year round. Now the time has come for the harvest, because hunting is not allowed here almost the whole year. Only few red deer hunters are accepted each year, because the hunting management wants to hold the high quality of the red stag hunts during the rut.

The management knows the expectations of the guests who often come from far away and wants to fulfil these demands of course. As with us, hunt fairness and sustainable hunting, as far as possible in hunting areas of this size, is written in capital letters. The Belarusian hunting staff is well trained and experienced in dealing with western guests. They are harsh nature boys, sometimes a bit taciturn, but always anxious to bring their guests to success. Enjoy a hunt in Europe's last primeval forest.

THE RUT- HIGHLIGHT OF THE HUNTING YEAR

Most deer hunters have already heard of the famous Rominten red deer.

Red deer, which trigger longings with their cup crown with each deer expert. Famous hunting painters have immortalized many of them artistically. Some exhibits can be admired in the East Prussian Museum. The antlers of the strongest stag of the Rominten Heath, the 'Matador', are exhibited in the German Hunting Museum in Munich. Hunting in the Russian part of the Rominten was done very intensively and the strong stags were reduced to a tenth. In addition, deer in the Polish part of the Rominten Heath lost their characteristic cup crown through the introduction of Silesian red deer. Therefore, since 2005 an attempt has been made to establish a population of Rominten deer in the Pripyat National Park. Since then, designated red deer experts have been responsible for building up this stock. For years we have been able to offer our customers a few mature red stags with the well-known cup crown.

This hunt is for experienced deer hunters, because you will rarely hunt from the high seat. It's a matter of stalking the calling stag. This is not always easy in this partly rough terrain and demands some drops of sweat from you. But it's worth the exertions, when you harvested such a stag. We receive the shooting list from the Belarusians every year and can therefore follow the development of the red deer very closely.

Mature and shootable stags carry antlers with weights between 7 kg and 9 kg. But every year there are also red deer that exceed the magic 10 kg limit. As with every hunt, it takes a little bit of luck. The rut usually begins in mid-September and lasts about 10 days. Please plan your trip so that you arrive around 15th or 16th of September. Then the best rutting days lie before you. You will be guided by local hunters who have learned their trade from the ground up and are very familiar with the way deer live. We all look forward to the coming rut with great optimism.

Hunting is always a matter of trust. You can rely on our specialists. Probably no other hunting agency in Germany has so much detailed knowledge about hunting in the Pripyet Marshes. In 1991 our team has been for the first time in this last European primeval forest. Since that time we have been intensively following the hunting management in the Pripyet Marshes and have invested a lot of time. But all our efforts and costs have paid off and we all have only one goal in mind:

... hunting the deer with the cup crown.

In the early nineties - when the first western hunters were drawn into the Pripet Marshes - everything was still very primitive, the guides inexperienced and the hunting management little trained in dealing with guest hunters.

This has all improved over the years, as hundreds of hunters travelled to this unique protected area at peak times due to the abundance of game in the Pripet swamps. Spoiled guests cannot be accommodated in primitive huts, so on the advice of experienced Western hunting outfitters a lot of money was spent (the hunting grounds in Pripjet are under the direct control of President Lukashenko).

Either you stay in the recently built hotel 'Over the Pripjet' in the small town Lyaskovichy or in one of the renovated hunting lodges. There are clean rooms, the sanitary facilities are good and nobody has had to complain about the food yet. All in all, Belarus has become a hunting country, where you can also safely take hunting companions with you. Let us advise you thoroughly and competently. We are looking forward to your inquiry.
