



HUNTING IN NAMIBIA


... HUNT THE 'UNKNOWN' NAMIBIA

Namibia is located in southwestern Africa, has an area of 842,269 square kilometers and has the second lowest population density in the world. One of the most interesting hunting countries in southern Africa. Until its independence, Namibia was a German colony.

For the first time this year, our partner and hunt organizer focused on the organsiation of driven hunts in the Kalahari. With our support and competence in the planning of driven hunts a convincing hunting concept could be developed. So far, hunting in Namibia has been more well known as a single hunt under the guidance of an experienced professional hunter. But the economic and ecological development is forcing the sheep and cattle farms to rethink. The years of drought and lack of water cause large losses among livestock and wildlife latest by September. There is just not enough feed left. Thus, the high wild populations of springbok, oryx and warthog are competitors for livestock. Our common hunt concept is to prevent wildlife from starvation or dehydration by using them in the natural food chain and thus providing farmers with a substitute.

When you land in Windhoek after a quiet morning flight, our partner will welcome you there and drive you straight to the Kalahari for the Bitterwasser Lodge. The journey takes about 2.5 to 3 hours. The Bitterwasser Lodge offers beautiful bungalows for single use as well as double rooms. After lunch we drive about 45 kilometers into the hunting area in the afternoon and the first activities are taken. Built on a red dune is our tent camp, where we take lunch or have the famous sundowner at the campfire. The fantastic view, the pleasant temperatures, the clear air, excellent food and cold drinks make for the best holiday mood. After sunset, we stay a little under the star tent before it goes back to the Bitterwasser Lodge. At around 8:00 pm we will have dinner.

The next morning we leave at around 7:30 to start at 9:00 clock with the first hunt. The drives takes about 1 hour, as a double drive with a short break up to 2 hours. The small group consists of 4 to a maximum of 6 hunters, who are strategically placed on swiveling chairs with a possibility of placing the weapon. The old large farms, which are much larger than the farms in northern Namibia, have blocks of 1,000 ha and more, bordered by 1-meter-high sheep fences, but the game skips easily. Due to the size of the hunting grounds, the game is slowly pushed by moving agricultural vehicles such as ATVs, pick ups or quads, towards the hunters.






... IN THE KALAHARI

There are various rental weapons available for a fee. We recommend weapons with lightweight silencers, to make sure shots on moving targets possible, calibers from 6.5 CM, 7mm and .30 calibers up to .300 Winchester Magnum.

After 4 hunting days, the return journey to Windhoek Airport takes place on the day of departure. If you leave early, you can take a detour through Windhoek to have lunch at Joe's Beerhouse and after that to the airport 40 kilometers away.

But if you still want to spend a few days for a 1:1 hunt, you will find fantastic hunting grounds as a guest on the Wendelstein farm of our partner near Gobabis. The hunting grounds of the area Plaas Welcom offer a high number of game species and an exciting stalking. In total, up to 120,000 ha are also available with the hunting ground Okambara. Enough area to challenge yourself as a stalker.

Important: There is no hunting on Saturdays. We therefore ask you to plan the Saturday as arrival or departure day.
