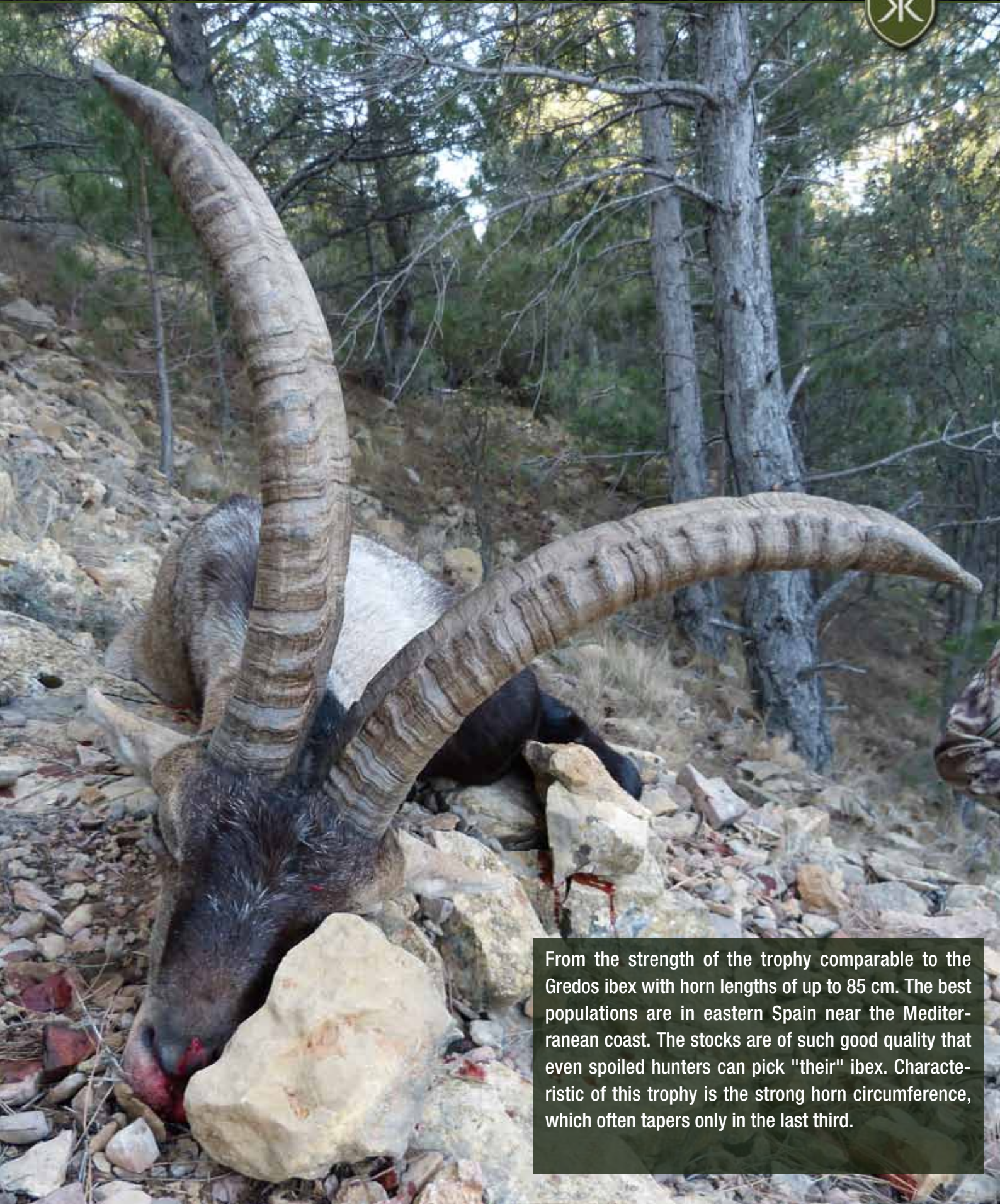


GREDOS IBEX

This species is hunted in the Gredos Mountains in central Spain. A good walkable mountain range (highest mountain is the Pico Almanzor with 2,592 m.) Shootable bucks have horn lengths up to 95 cm with a strong base. Characteristic jewelry bulges, as with the Sibirian ibexes, are missing or weak. In any case an impressive trophy, which should not be missing in any collection. Typically the lyre form, in many variations.



BECEITE IBEX

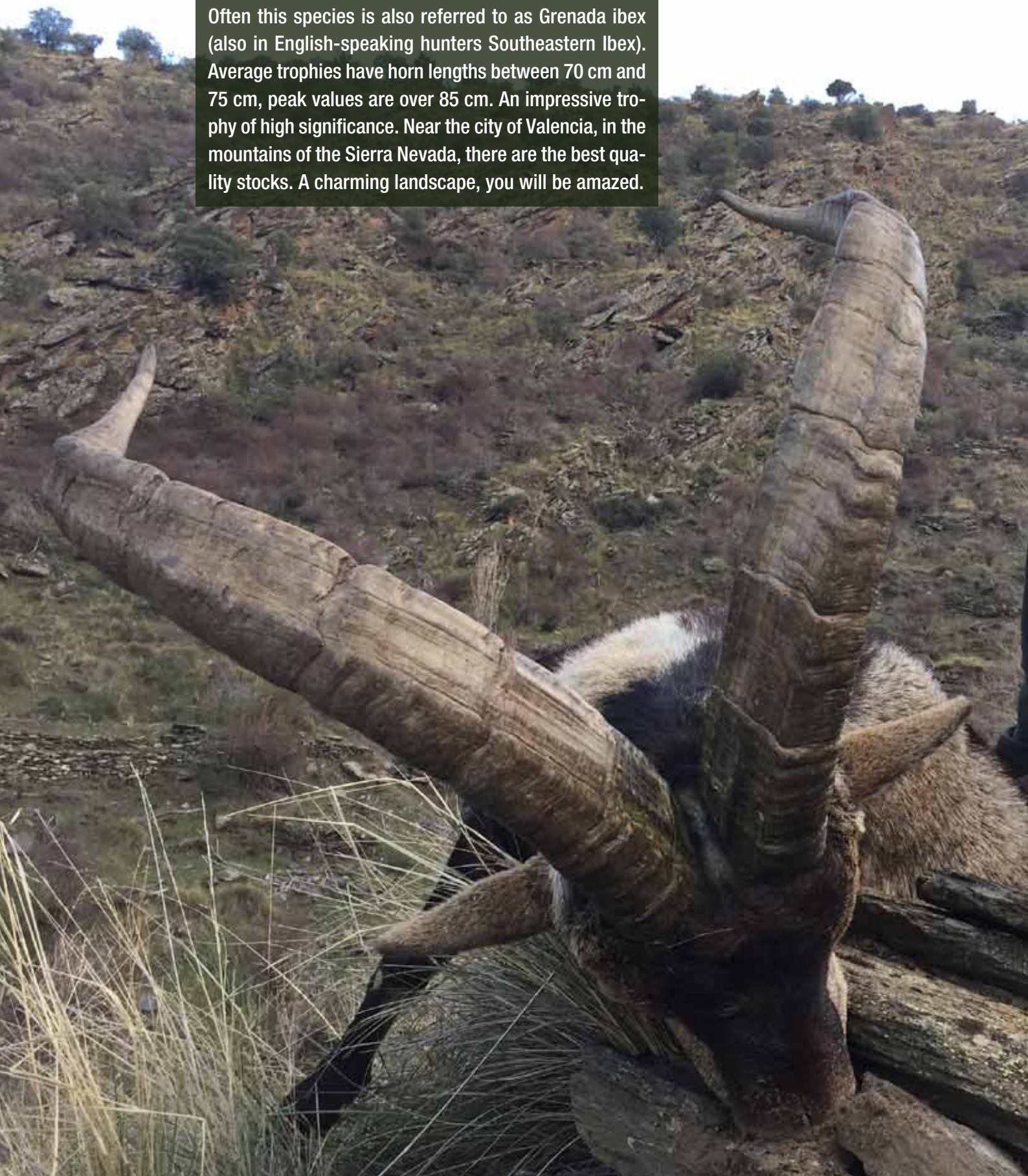


From the strength of the trophy comparable to the Gredos ibex with horn lengths of up to 85 cm. The best populations are in eastern Spain near the Mediterranean coast. The stocks are of such good quality that even spoiled hunters can pick "their" ibex. Characteristic of this trophy is the strong horn circumference, which often tapers only in the last third.



SIERRA-NEVADA IBEX

Often this species is also referred to as Grenada ibex (also in English-speaking hunters Southeastern Ibex). Average trophies have horn lengths between 70 cm and 75 cm, peak values are over 85 cm. An impressive trophy of high significance. Near the city of Valencia, in the mountains of the Sierra Nevada, there are the best quality stocks. A charming landscape, you will be amazed.





Regarding physical size and trophy the smallest of the Iberians. Ronda ibexes live in southern Spain in the mountains of the same name. It's a very popular species, because the trophy can best be compared with that of an Alpine ibex. Capital bucks have horn lengths between 60 cm and 70 cm. The highest point in the Ronda Mountains is the Torrecilla, at only 1,919 m. Even older hunters are recommended to hunt in this region (Malaga).



HUNT IN THE MOUNTAINS

What could be better than hunting in the mountains? Many of us know the chamois hunting from local areas, but the highlight is stalking for the king of the Spanish mountains, the Iberian ibex. Four different subspecies of this interesting game can be hunted, unique in Europe.

At hectic times such as these, time is a precious commodity, and so in recent years we have seen a steady increase in hunters who choose to hunt in Spain. Ibex hunts do not last long, the hunting areas are easy to reach and, above all, the wallet is spared. As a rule, two full hunting days are enough for getting your ibex.

There are cheap flights to all regions of Spain, the import of weapons is a mere matter of form and you can usually take your trophy directly with you. We take care of the paperwork. Just enjoy a few hunting days in the beautiful mountains of Spain. Depending on the hunting area you live in small hotels or country inns. You will not miss the home comforts. Hunting is very important in Spain and hunters are valued accordingly. Anyone who has ever hunted in Spain and got to know the Spanish way of life and hospitality, will gladly come again.

In no other hunting country in Europe we register such a high rate of repeated bookings. It is appealing to reach the Spanish "Grand Slam", the shooting of all four sub-

species of the Iberian ibex. For Spain, you do not need special clothing. Depending on the season, windproof, warming and breathable outerwear as well as well-worn ankle-stabilizing footwear with a grippy outsole are required. Take with you a pair of lightweight binoculars, the best with a tenfold magnification, a rangefinder and a powerful caliber. For mountain hunting we recommend calibers such as 6.5 x 68, 8 x 68 S and all calibers from the 300 group.

"When is the best hunting season?" we are often asked. Due to the long hunting season and the high populations you have a large time window for all ibex species. You always have very good chances of success.

Many of the hunts are done in late winter and spring. This is also because many hunters in the fall have a busy schedule and one hunt follows the next. In spring, it is quiet in domestic hunting areas and those who want to escape the carnival, can also hunt in February. Get detailed and competent advice from our specialists.

Tourism, noise and sunny beaches! You will not find anything like that in our hunting grounds. The most interesting game for many hunters are undoubtedly the different species of the Iberian ibex. Those who are reluctant to tackle the strenuous mountain hunts in Kazakhstan or Kyrgyzstan, who are not prepared to pay the high expenses of an Alpine ibex hunt in Austria or Slovenia, are in good hands in Spain.

The cost of an Iberian ibex is moderate, the physical effort is limited and success is almost guaranteed, despite you are hunting in the wild. The stocks are high and of such good quality that in recent years all our guests got the chance to shoot. The last years, we have accompanied most of our guests to ibex hunting in Spain and therefore we know the local conditions very well. Every year we are in Spain to keep up to date with population changes in different regions. Use this wealth of experience that hardly any other German-speaking hunting agency can offer you.
